- All Day Events and Notes:
  - Pistol and rifle range, 20yd to 200yd options. Shooters must supply their own gun and ammo. Targets for sale at facility if needed. There will be a couple loaner guns available...talk with us in advance if needed.
  - Clay pigeon shooting. Shooters must supply their own gun and ammo. Targets available for sale at event if needed.
  - Archery range, including a 13-station 3D target range.
  - A seminar on tracking.
  - Fly casting demonstration and lessons.

Notes:

1. BBQ competition is specifically chicken and pork ribs. Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Note that electricity is not available so if your tool requires it, please bring a generator. Ditto water. The only smoker heat sources acceptable are wood and/or charcoal. Competitors provide their own smokers, food,...everything. Judging criteria will be taste, presentation/appearance and tenderness/texture. Foods turned in for judging to be in disposable containers. Turn-in time will be 4:00.
2. Dutch Oven competition. Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places. The only rule is all the cooking occur while on site. Judging based on taste, presentation and simplicity. Contestants must have a steel plate to work as the “floor” of their cooking space. Turn-in time will be 3:00.
3. Businesses present will be at no cost unless they choose to vend and if so, will pay a \$36 entrance fee to cover costs Man-Staff will be incurring from the park.
